<sup>1</sup> New Ontario Regulation 47/09 was made under Bill 119, *An Act to amend the Workplace Safety and Insurance Act, 1997*. Bill 119 introduces mandatory coverage in the construction industry to independent operators, sole proprietors, some partners in a partnership and some executive officers. It received royal assent on November 27, 2008. The Regulation exempts certain partners and executive officers in construction firms from mandatory coverage. When the legislation comes into force in 2012, one partner in a partnership carrying on business in construction or one executive officer of a corporation carrying on business in construction is exempt from the application of the Act. The partner or executive officer must not perform any construction work and must file a declaration with the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board.

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
